

Instruction for school buses vans and three wheeler drivers

- Limiting number of students only to the number of seats available in the vehicle.
- Providing facilities, sanitizers to clean hands when getting in and off the vehicle.
- Keeping the vehicle interior of the vehicle properly ventilated by opening all shutters and not operating the air conditioners.
- Taking action to prevent students removing facemasks and exchanging food inside the vehicle.
- Transporting same students every day.
- Transporting students of one school in a one vehicle.
- Keeping records of the students traveling in the vehicle.
- Keeping a register to record the traveling of students on daily basis.
- Not transporting others in the vehicles transporting schoolchildren.
- Not allowing others to enter vehicle after students leaving vehicle to school.
- Looking for sick students when entering them to the vehicle in the morning.
- Not transporting students from the isolated areas.
- The driver and the assistant always wearing facemasks.
- Cleaning the parts of the vehicle touched by students, every day before entering and after leaving the vehicle.
- Displaying contact numbers of health sector people on the vehicle for emergency contact.
- Employ same driver and assistant always.
- Not employing unfamiliar people in the vehicle.
- Not changing drivers often /every day.
- If the driver or assistant is sick not employing them.
- Have a method to check body temperature of driver and the assistant in the morning before starting their work.
- Taking action to prevent drivers chewing beetle or removing facemasks while on duty.
- Make sure always have one student be seated in one seat.
