The matters that should be taken into account in presenting articles

The instructions given here are imposed from 01.01.2022 over any other instructions given in this regard earlier.

The name or any other information about the author should not be given anywhere else in the article, except the covering letter of the article.

The following details should be provided by the covering letter.

- *Author's information (Name, Post etc.)*
- *Contact Details (Official & Private Address, Telephone No., Email)*
- *Short account of the author (Academic Qualifications, Publications etc.)*

1. Content of the article in Sinhala, Tamil or English should be arranged in following order.
 - (i) Summary : 150 - 200 words including 3 key words
 - (ii) Introduction : Nature of the issue, background, rationale
 - (iii) Literature review : Theoretical and practical background
 - (iv) Methodology : Objectives, strategy of achieving objectives, method of data collection, analysis and interpretation
 - (v) Discussion, Interpretation and Findings
 - (vi) Conclusions
 - (vii) Suggestions and Recommendations

Altogether, the article should not exceed 6000 words.
2. Supplementary materials such as sketches, pictures, photos, maps and graphs (maximum 4) should be produced in high quality suitable for printing and with the clearance of copyright if any. The statistical tables longer than one page should be numbered and given at the end of the article as annexes.
3. Foot notes are not allowed, but the numbered notes added to the end of the article is allowed.
4. Follow the American Psychological Association (APA citation guide - 7th edition) for the references at the end of the article. [For examples please browse the web www.bibme.org/citation-guide and select the topic "Useful Guide to APA Format"]
5. Page size and layout should be as follows:
A4 with a margin of 25mm (portrait) - doubled line space - one side
Font size : Topic - 16pt Headings - 14pt Text - 12pt
 Sinhala – FM Abaya Tamil – Kalaham English – Times New Roman
6. Submission of the articles:
Two hard copies with one soft copy (MS Words) which is not converted in to PDF format should be submitted before **15th of March 2022** to the following address.
