External Resource Persons who are currently providing services as well as those who are willing to provide services in the sphere of education to the Ministry of Education (MoE) are kindly requested to formally register at the Ministry.

Directory of External Resource Persons: Persons selected will be registered in the Directory of External Resource Persons at the MoE. Persons must be qualified, experienced, competent and suitable for rendering services in education. They include Professors, Lecturers. Senior Teachers, Educators, School Principals, Retired Education Officers, Consultants, Professionals, Entrepreneurs, Public Officers, and Officers ir Armed Forces as well as organizations offering professional services. Their services are obtained on the basis of visiting/assignment/contract/project or invitation.

Applying for Registration: Refer the details in the MoE website, and apply on the Form downloadable from: www.moe.gov.lk and email to: edureformsrp@gmail.com Applications will be closed on March 20, 2023.

Scope of Work: Applicants must be able to serve as *Trainer of Trainers/ Lecturers/ Trainer/ Consultant* in General Education, and Technical and Vocational Education. They will deliver their services with respect to (a) school teachers (b) school principals (c) officers in education administration (d) academic staff in National Colleges of Education, (e) staff in technical and vocational institutes, and other categories of personnel in education.

The Spheres of Work include the following:

a. Learning-teaching process, including learning-teaching methods, curriculum delivery in school, learning assessment, and management of data and information relating to education

- b. Curriculum development and related teacher training, in priority areas including STEM education, English and business communication; Vocational skills development. ICT and AI, and entrepreneurship
- c. Management of schools, including planning, classroom management, finance, and school culture
- d. Career development and counselling, including aptitude testing, testing career preferences, and providing counselling to students
- e. Education administration, including implementation of National Education Management Information System at school, school board, zonal and provincial and national levels
- f. Capacity building of personnel in various categories of services in education aimed at higher performance and career progress/succession planning.
