All Island Inter Schools Muslim Cultural Competition - 2024

All Island Inter Schools Muslim Cultural Competition organized by the Muslim Schools Development Branch of Ministry of Education will be held annually from 2024. You are hereby informed to make all the schools aware in this regard. Further, I kindly request to provide facilities and opportunities to the students to present their creative abilities in these competitions.

Introduction

Through these competitions organized by the Muslim Schools Development Branch of The Ministry of Education, it is anticipated to provide opportunity to asses Islamic cultural, artistic and aesthetic values and to develop skills. Priority in University admission will be given to the students who achieve national level awards.

Vision

1. To develop students' personality traits and create responsible citizens through developing Islamic religious, cultural and aesthetic values and to contribute to create good citizens through intensifying national and international relationship

Objectives

- 1. Using methods that express aesthetic emotions in line with Islamic identity
- 2 Motivation to protect traditional, aesthetic and cultural values
- 3. Development of skills and knowledge of various Islamic arts and languages

Categories of Competition

This will be held under four categories including three major categories and one open category

- 1. Junior Secondary Competition Category Grade 06, 07, 08
- 2. Senior Secondary Competition Category Grade 09, 10, 11
- 3. Senior Competition Category Grade 12, 13
- 4. Open Competition Category (No age limit)

2. Conditions of Participation

- 2.1. It is the responsibilty of the Principals to read and understand this circular and to make the the participating students and teachers in charge aware of the same
- 2.2. Students of Government schools and Private schools approved by the Ministry of Education are eligible to participate in these competitions.
- 2.3. Students from grade 06 to 13 and those who sit for G.C.E. (Advanced Level) Examination in the year 2023 at first attempt are eligible to participate.
- 2.4. Out of 28 events mentioned in table 5.1 one school can compete in only 14 events. One participant can compete in only two events including one individual event and an open competition category or a group event under one category.
- 2.5. The songs selected for the competition should not include any lines that may provoke racial, religious diversity, political ideologies or violate Islamic ethics but apt to school students. Further, when singing Qaseeda, Al-Hiqaya Wal Baith (song and verse), Marhaba Baith (welcome song), Arabic prounciations should be properly articulated.
- 2.6. With the application form, the letter of recommendation by of Principal should be annexed to certify the songs, scripts of Nasheed, Mas'ala (poetry style literature), Al Hikaya Wal Baith (song and verse) and open competition category such as Ar-Raksur Rabani (Rabn dance) Stick Dance, Social Drama and Malay Cultural Programme are own creations of students.
- 2.7. Provincial level qualified competitors' creations must be certified by the Zonal Director of Education and submitted to Provincial Director of Education. National level qualified competitors should get their creations certified by Provincial Director of Education and submitted to the Director of Education of the Ministry of Education (Muslim Schools Development)
- 2.8. Zonal, Provincial and National Level competitors should take part in school uniform and should not display anything to highlight the identity of the school.
- 2.9. Competitors of Mas'ala (poetry style literature), Al-Hikaya Wal Baith (song and verse) and all open competitions categories are allowed to wear a suitable cultural dress. The responsibility of the dress code has to be taken by the principal of the school and teacher-in-charge.

3. Conditions of the Competition

- 3.1 These competitions will be held in four segments such as School, Zonal, Provincial and National levels. The principal has to certify the identity of competitors.
- 3.2 Zonal level competitions will be organized by The Zonal Director of Education.
- 3.3. All the responsibilities of the provincial level competitions are assigned to the provincial Director of Education. As per this circular the decision of the Provincial Director of Education will be the final decision with related to the provincial level competition.
- 3.4. Zonal competitions should be conducted before the date mentioned in this circular and the results should be sent to the Provincial Director of Education in order to organize provincial level competitions.
- 3.5 The same competitor has to compete from school level to National level under Individual category. Due to unavoidable circumstances a competitor can be replaced under open category or group events with the consent of Zonal/ Provincial Director of Education after examining valid proofs.
- 3.6. A competitor who represents a school in the initial competition must represent the same school in all the other levels of the competitions. If a competitor has left the school and joined another school, it must be strictly concerned.
- 3.7. All competitions will be provided with 30 seconds an extra in addition to the allocated time.
- 3.8. During the Zonal and Provincial level competitions, decisions should not be made so as to give equal points. Only the first-place winning school will be qualified to compete at the National level competitions.
- 3.9. Zonal and Provincial Directors of Education should certify that all competitions are conducted according to the circular and with trapseparency since first, second and third places of national level competitions will be given priority to University entrance.

4. Conducting competitions, organising and appointing the panel of judges

- 4.1. The relevant details of this competition are attached herewith, with the signature of the Director of Education (Muslim School Development)
- 4.2. While applying for competitions applications must be prepared as per the application form attached to this circular.
- 4.3. The school level competitions should be completed by 10 March 2024 and the results should be submitted to the Zonal Director of Education. The zonal competitions should be completed by April 30, 2024 and the results should be submitted to the Provincial Director of Education and the provincial competitions should be completed by June 30, 2024 and the results should be submitted to the Director of Education, Muslim Schools Development Branch of the Ministry of Education. The name of the school should be mentioned correctly in the provincial competition result sheet.
- 4.4. The national level final should be held and completed by September 15, 2024.
- 4.5. The panel of judges for school and Zonal competitions should be appointed by the Zonal Director of Education, and the panel of judges for Provincial competitions should be appointed the Provincial Director of Education of the respective province, on the recommendations of the Islam, aesthetic or Tamil medim officers of the Zonal/province. The composition of the panel of judges for the finals will be determined on the recommendation of the Assistant/ Deputy Director of Education and the approval of the Director of Education for Muslim Schools Development Branch of the Ministry of Education. However, if any conflict arises with regard to subject matter, a decision will be taken after a discussion with the panel of judges with the consent of The Director of Education for Muslim Schools Development Branch of the Ministry of Education

6. The Panel of Judges

6.1 A panel of judges with required qualifications, experience and Islamic cultural background and proficieny in the respective fields will be appointed by Zonal/ Provincial and National level organizers with the recommendation of the Islam Subject Director of the Zonal / Provincial Education Department. Thus, the decision of the panel of judges will be considered final. Competition organizers will not interference in any decision.

7. Complaints and Appeals

- 7.1 There shall be no interference from parents, politicians, external parties of the school, well wishers or alumni associations. In the matter of competitions, complaints submitted by them will not be entertained.
- 7.2 If one or more competitions are conducted contrary to the circular or annexure or if any conflicts arise with regard to the competion procedures:
 - 7.2.1. In the case of Zonal level competitions the School Principal or Divisional Director of Education and in the case of Provincial level competitions, the Zonal Director of Education, the Coordinator of Zonal competions must submit the complaint in writing along with the relevant evidence before announcing the results of the competition
 - 7.2.2. In the case of National level competitions, the Provincial competition coordinator or the Provincial Director of Education should submit the complaint in writing to the main organizer of the competition office along with the relevant evidence before announcing the results
 - 7.2.3. Attention will be paid only if there is any problem in the competition procedure.

8. Awarding Certificates

- 8.1 Certificates will be awarded to students who win at the School, Zonal and Provincial level competitions. It must be organized by the respective School/ Zonal/ Provincial Department.
- 8.2 For those win the competitions in National level, the certificates will be awarded by the Ministry of Education.
- 8.3 All contestants and concerned parties participating in the competitions shall at all times follow the rules and regulations mentioned in the said circular and shall accept the decisions of the judges as final.

School participating in the National level finals should read and understand the attachment of the competition schedule carefully and should get the signatures of the principals to participate in the competitions. If any violation of the competition rules mentioned in this circular found, the Secretary of Ministry of Education has the authority to take the final decision in this regard.


