DUTY HOURS AND TEACHING OF THE SUBJECT - TEACHERS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION.

All teachers holding appointments as teachers of Physical Education and Sports should teach the of Physical Education in schools, whether they hold such post as trained teachers, Diploma of Colleges of Education, Untrained or trainee teachers, and they should not be called upon to other subjects.

If there are teachers at present who are holding appointments as Teachers of Physical Education ourts and are engaged in the teaching of other subjects, they should be assigned the subject of all Education. If there is no possiblity of allocating the required number of periods, such teachers he transferred to schools where vacancies occur or should be attached to some other school for a of the week.

Every teacher of Physical Education should teach the subjet of Physical Education for a mini-20 hours per week and these periods should be utilized only for the teaching of basic skills in and activities included in the syllabus.

Traning of School Teams for various Sports and training of School Cadets should not be included **School Time Table** and should be done in the evening, after school hours. Time devoted for training after school could be inculdied in the apporoved Time Table.
