Procedure of awarding marks for the Structured Interview to appoint Grade I Officers of the Sri Lanka Education Administrative Service to the Posts of Director of Education / Commissioner

01. Seniority

Maximum marks: 50

(The marks will be awarded as the officers are entitled for the marks per year from the date of promotion to Grade-I of the Sri Lanka Education Administrative Service, the officer with highest service period in Grade I gets the total marks allocated as per Public Service Commission Circular No. 01/2019, and the other officers get the marks proportionally for their period of service in Grade I)

Note: In respect of the officers who have been promoted to Grade I subsequent to the completion of 12 years of active and satisfactory service period in Grade II and III with a service period of two (02) years in Grade II of the Sri Lanka Education Administrative Service, their active and satisfactory service period additional to the said total service period of 12 years and two years in Grade II will also be considered as a service period in Grade I and the marks will be awarded accordingly.

No marks are awarded for the researches / theses submitted for the Post Graduate Degree/Post Graduate Diploma, and marks are awarded only for research reports submitted to a **Symposium** or published in a **Research Journal**.

(No marks are given for the text books and affiliated books thereof, and only the books and magazines; with an individual authorship, approved by the Educational Publications Advisory Board and marks will be considered for awarding marks.

- 3.3 02 marks each; for a maximum of 05 marks, are given for reports and academic collections submitted for educational publications

6. Presentation

Maximum Marks-10

Marks are given as follows for a presentation done by analyzing a case faced by you based on a preliminary incident that increases the quality and productivity in the education system while you are performing the duties and responsibilities at your institute (School/Ministry of Education/Provincial Department of Education/Zonal Education Office/Divisional Education Office)

- 02 Marks I. Approach & Introduction - 02 Marks II. Contents - 02 Marks III. Time Management IV. Way of Presentation - 02 Marks V. Finishing & Conclusion - 02 Marks

An oral presentation should be done for a timeframe of 05 minutes via Power Point Application or any other application by using a computer, and the hard copy of the case study you presented should be handed over to the Interview Board.
