National Level Presentation Competition for Grade 6-13 Bilingual Students

The Bilingual Education Branch of the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education is pleased to inform you of the National Level Presentation Competition for Grade 6-13 Bilingual students of government and government approved private schools.

This competition aims to promote bilingualism, encourage effective communication and foster self confidence among our young learners.

Key details of the competition are as follows:

The themes of the competition are as follows

For Grades 6-9

: "Protect Environment for sustainable future"

For Grades 10-13

: "Climate change: A Global Threat, A local Responsibility"

These themes focus on students' engagement related to the above concepts and their involvement and application in day to day life. Also these themes invite the students to explore the concepts of sustainability and climate change and how they can contribute to minimize the environmental impact. Furthermore, the students are encouraged to reflect on their responsibilities as global citizens.

In addition the given themes are important to inspire creative and thoughtful presentations from the participating students enhancing their 21st century skills.

Accordingly the teams are expected to develop a topic reflecting the given themes highlighting the authentic applications. Participants are expected to develop their presentation and the PPT.


Rules and Regulations:

To ensure fairness and smooth conduct of the competition, the following rules and regulations will be implemented:

1. Eligibility: The competition is open to all grades 6-13 Bilingual Education (BE) students under two categories.

Category I Grades 6-9		Junior category	
Category II Grades 10-13		Senior category	

Each school can enter one team from each category.



- 2. **Team Size**: Each team should consist of five students, representing each grade. The 5th member can be selected from any grade. Once registered no school can change the members of the team.
- 3. **Original Content**: All presentations must be original and plagiarism of any form will lead to disqualification. References should be mentioned.
 - Presentation Format: Each team will be required to create the power point presentation
 with a maximum of ten content slides. Time limit for each presentation will be as
 follows.

Junior category

-10 minutes

Senior category

-15 minutes

Time will be counted with the first utterance / sounds.

5. Criteria for Judging: The judging will be based on the following criteria:

• Content (accuracy, depth, relevance and creativity)

- 30 points

• Presentation skills (clarity, audibility, confidence)

- 30 points
- Quality of the PPT(effective use of facts, statistics, details, images and design of the slides)
 20 points

· Team work and Collaboration

- 10 points

• Time Management

- 10 points

6. General Instructions:

The decision of the judging panel will be the final. Soft copies of the winning provincial presentations should be submitted to the Director of education Bilingual Education Branch, MOE through the provincial BE Coordinators. All students should participate in school uniforms.

7. Selection:

Zonal Level Competition

1st, 2nd and 3rd places will be selected and only the 1st place of each category is eligible for Provincial Level Competition.

Provincial Level Competition

1st, 2nd and 3rd places are selected and both 1st and 2nd places of each category is eligible for National Level Competition.

National Level Competition

 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} places are selected and in addition, ten merits will be awarded for each category.
