Note: Install the application only on a Desktop or Smart Board device permanently located in the school



## Step-by-step guide:

1. Download the Daily Check App exe file.



 a. Click on the download icon found in the below link to save the executable file into your computer:




- 2. Run the downloaded exe file.
  - a. Once the download is completed double click to open it and click "Next" then click "Install" to begin the installation process.


**Note:** In some cases, if antivirus software is installed on your computer, it may change the extension of the downloaded file. If this happens, rename the file back to <a href="exe">.exe</a> and double-click to run it.



3. Open the installed application and enter your school Census No under School ID to get

started.







#### Important:

- Install the application only on a Desktop or Smart Board device permanently located in the school
- Do not install it on laptops or smartphones.
- If the device where the application is installed is replaced or formatted, reinstall the application on the upgraded device.
- The application will frequently update automatically. When you receive a notification through a popup box, make sure to restart the device and continue the update.

- A School Internet connection
- Installed operating system of Windows 7 or higher with 500 Mb of free disk space
